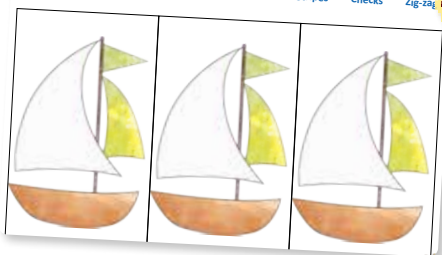

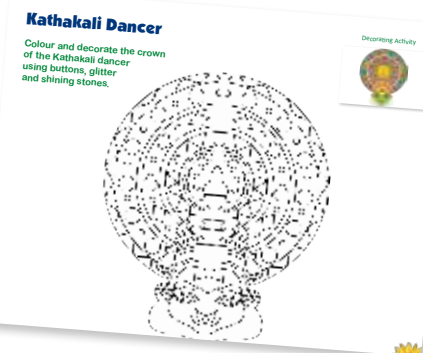
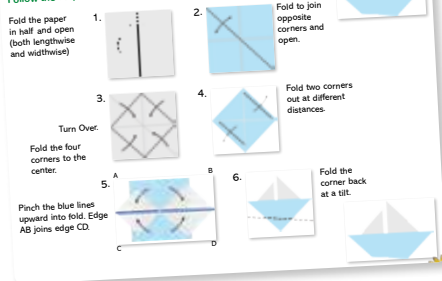

# Preface

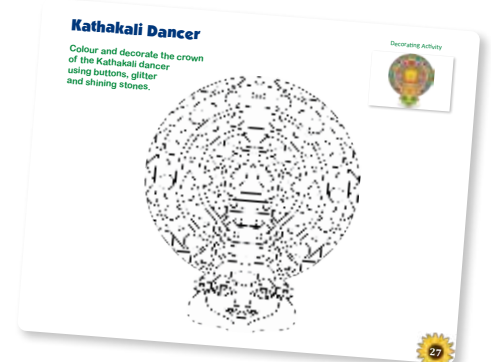
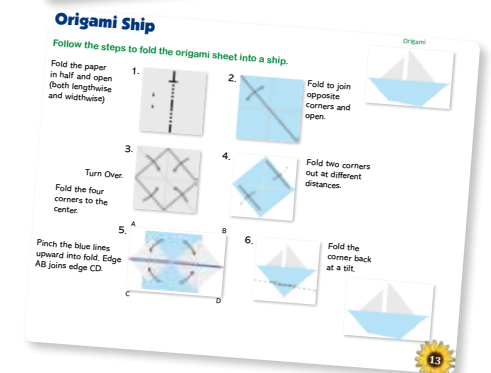
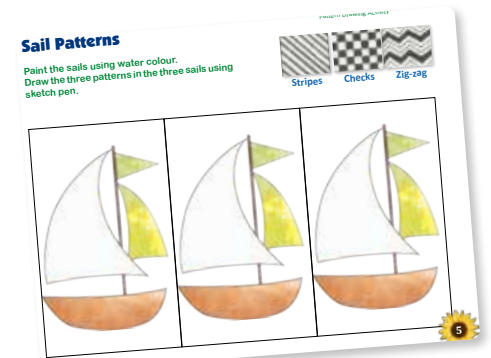

**The key features of the series ART FAIR (grades A,B,C and 1 to 8) are:**

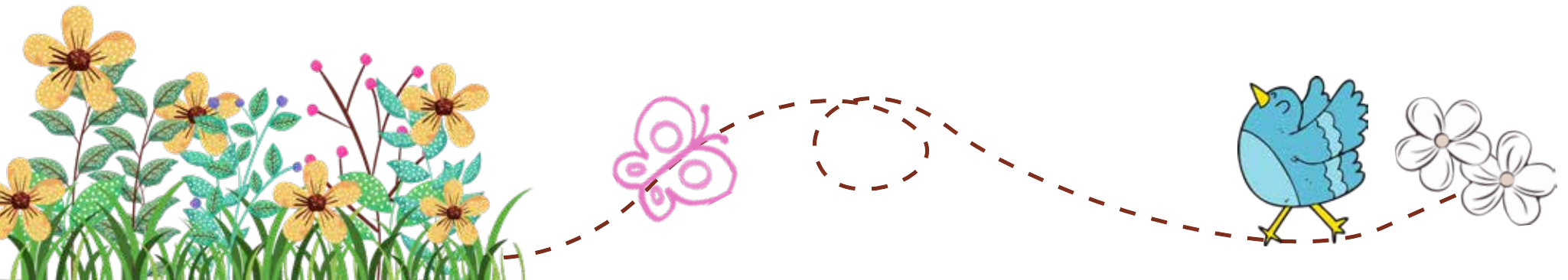
- Students will be introduced to local and folk art which makes this art series relatable, relevant and interesting.

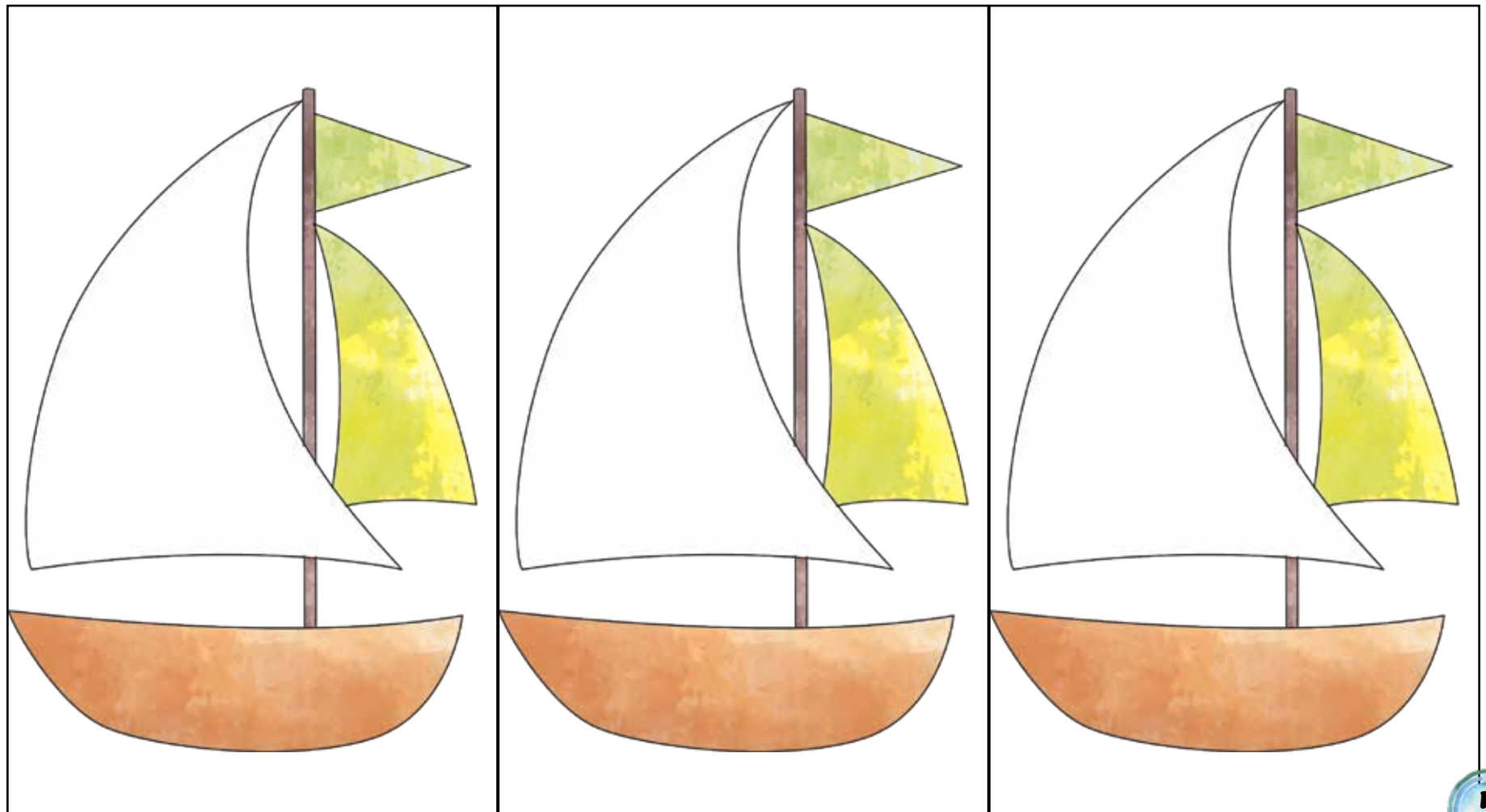

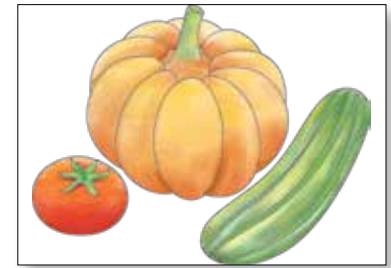

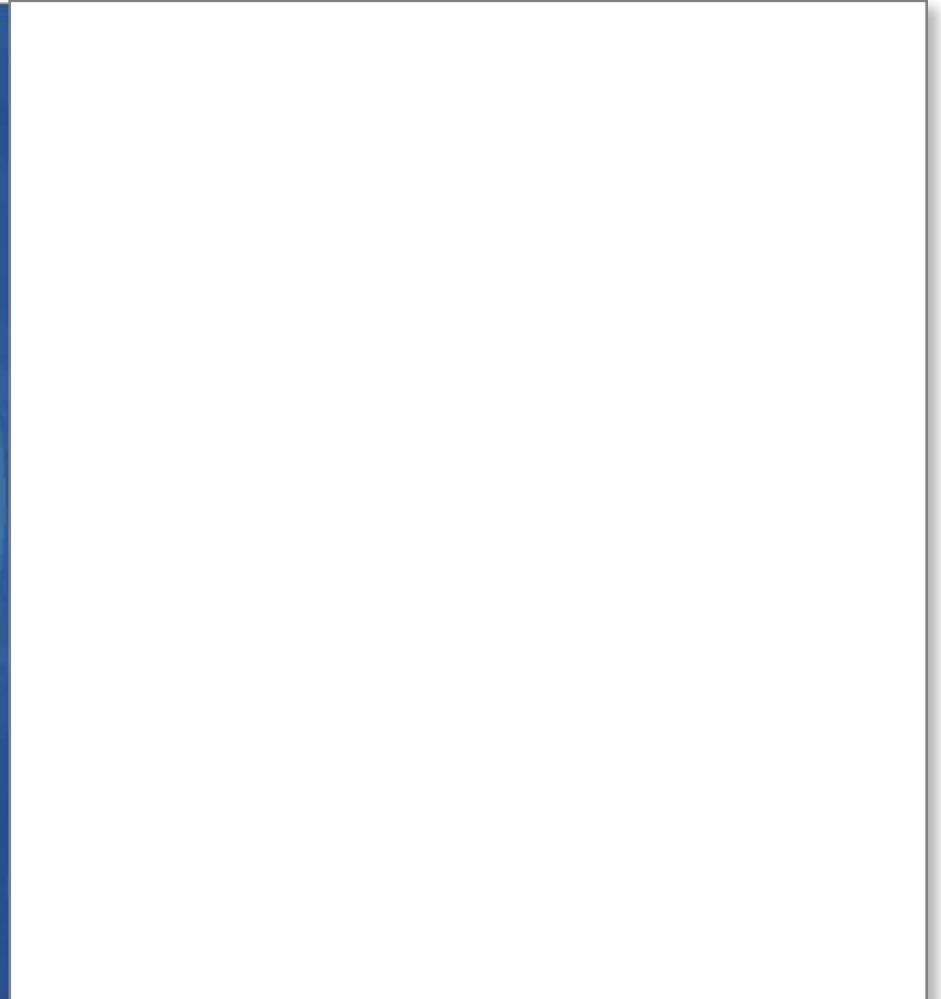

Colour the picture. Paste matchsticks to make fans to complete the picture. Colour the tip of matchstick with sketch pen.

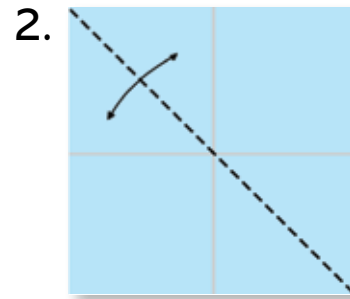
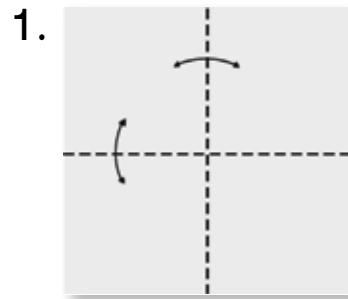

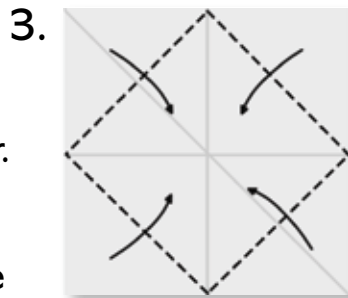
# Origami Ship

Fold the paper in half and open (both lengthwise and widthwise)

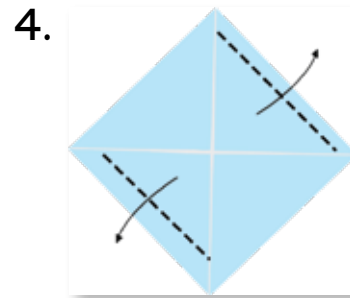


Fold to join opposite corners and open.



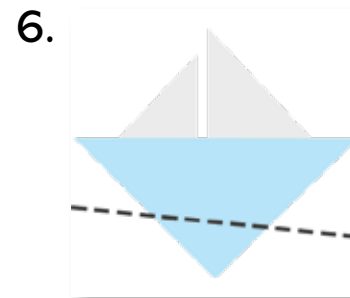
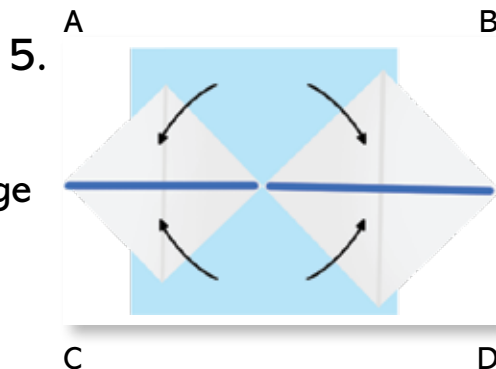
Turn Over.

Fold the four corners to the center.

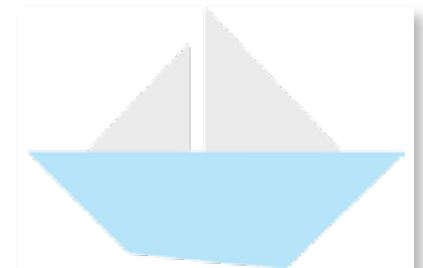
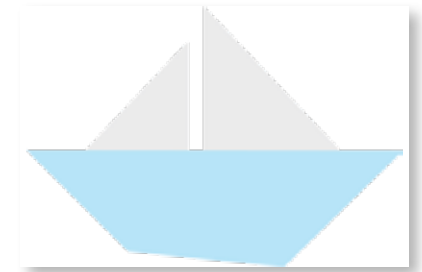


Fold two corners out at different distances.
