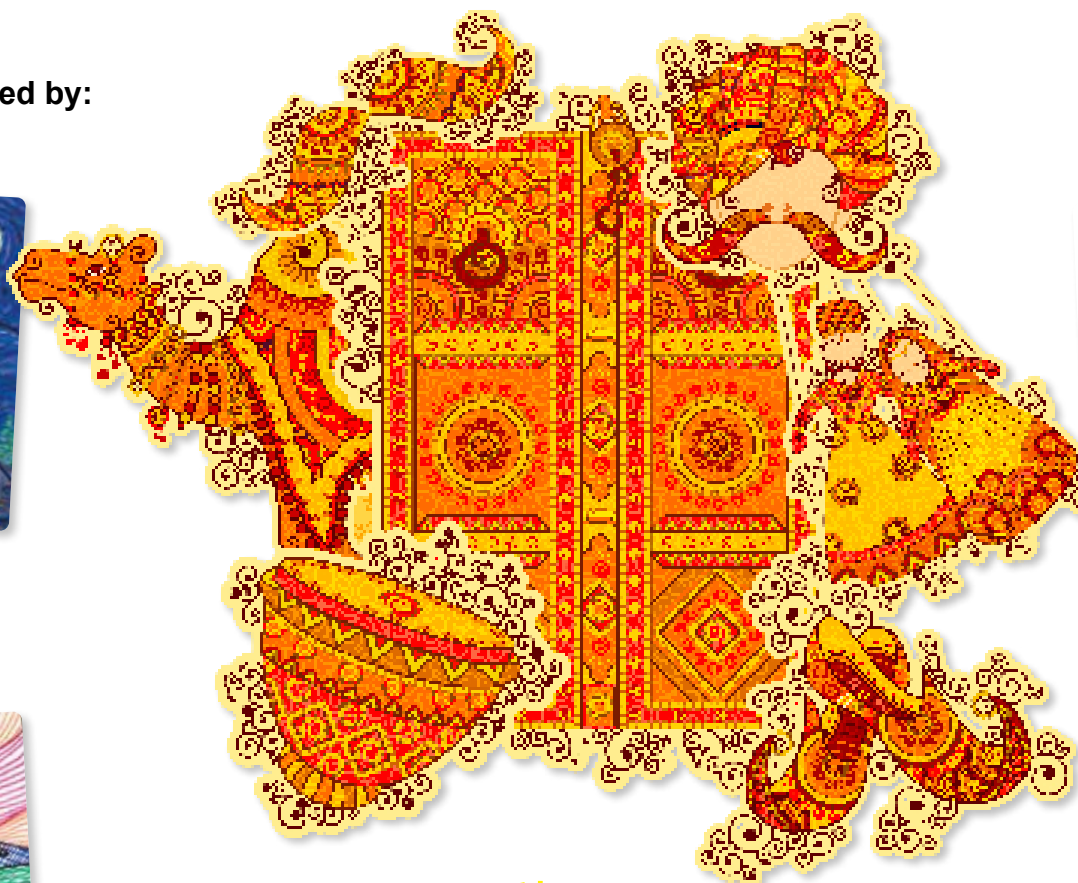

Preface

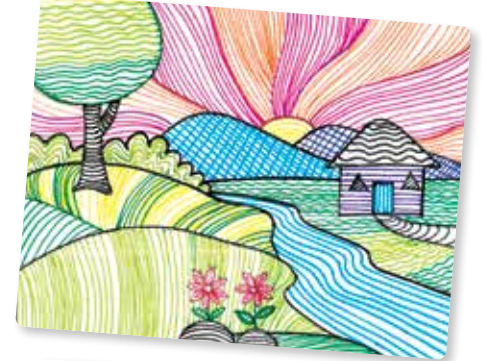

The key features of the series **ART FAIR (grades A,B,C and 1 to 8)** are:

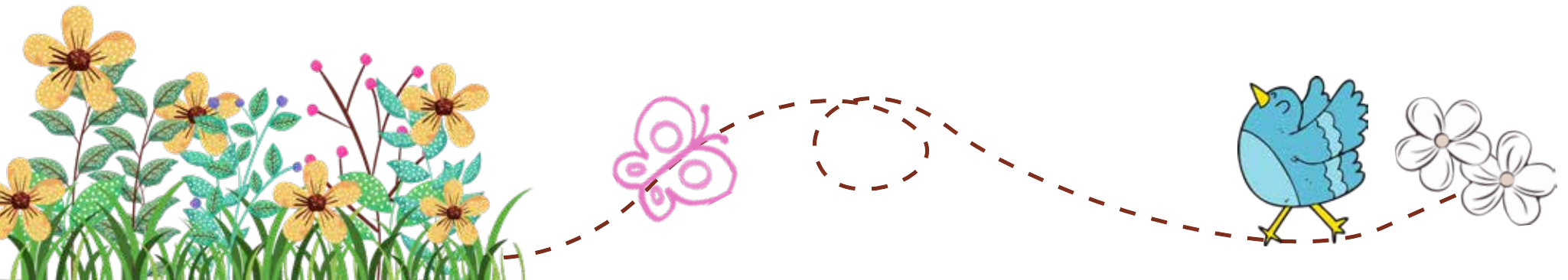
- Students will be introduced to local and folk art which makes this art series relatable, relevant and interesting.

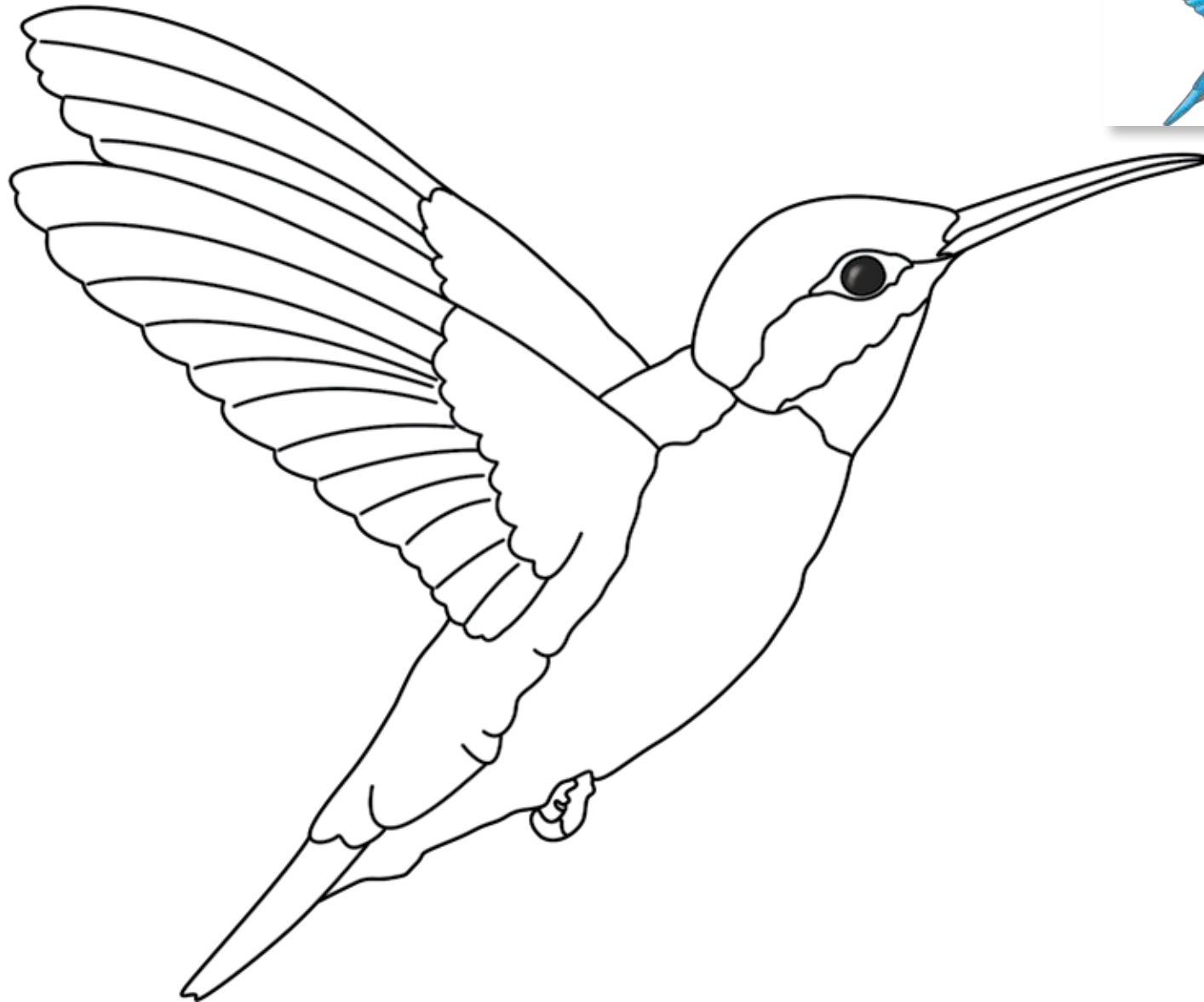

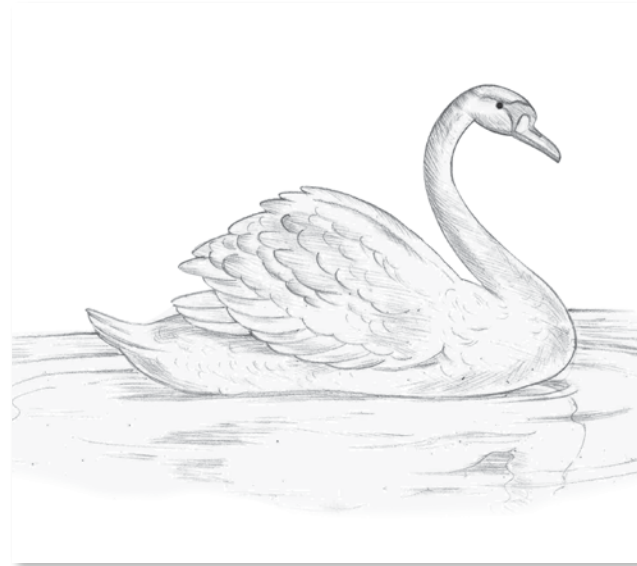

Rakhi Making

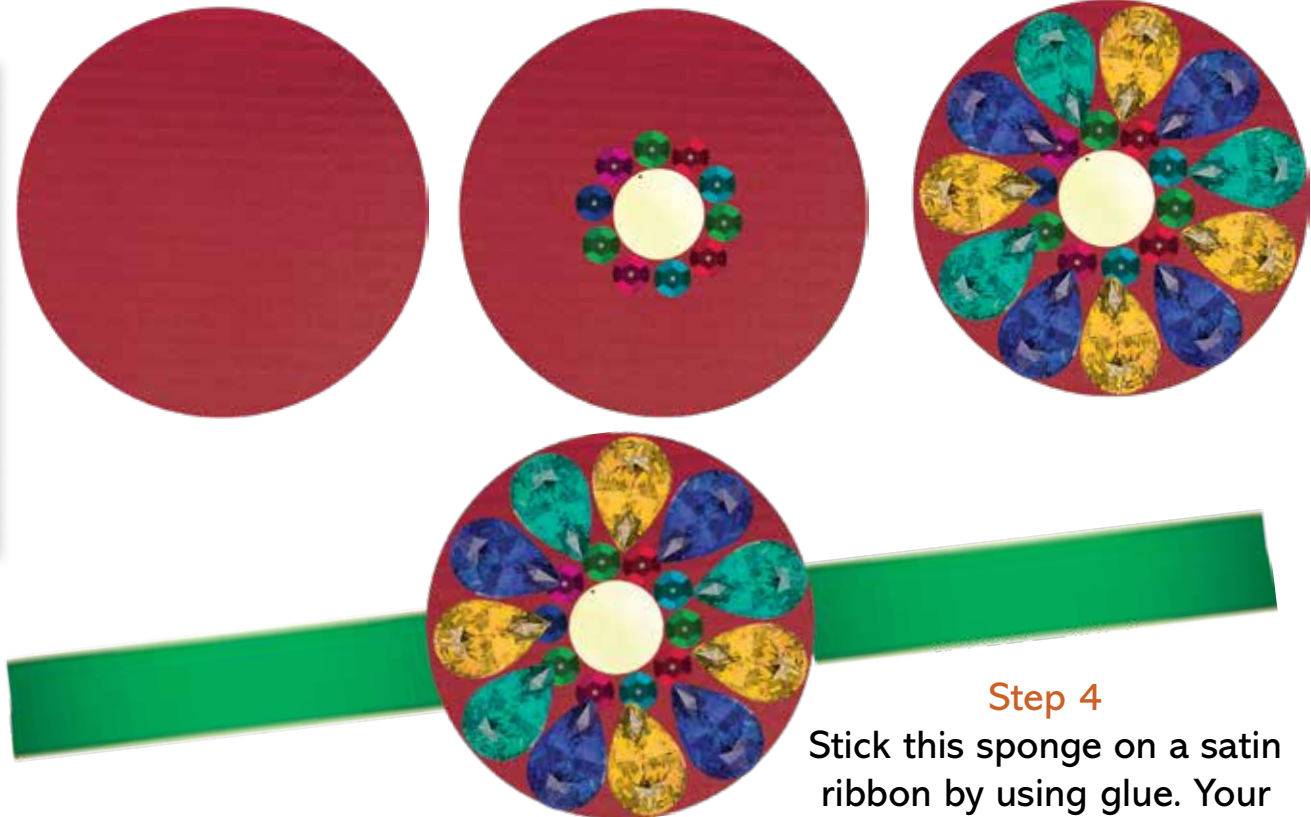

Stick bigger sequins around the smaller ones.

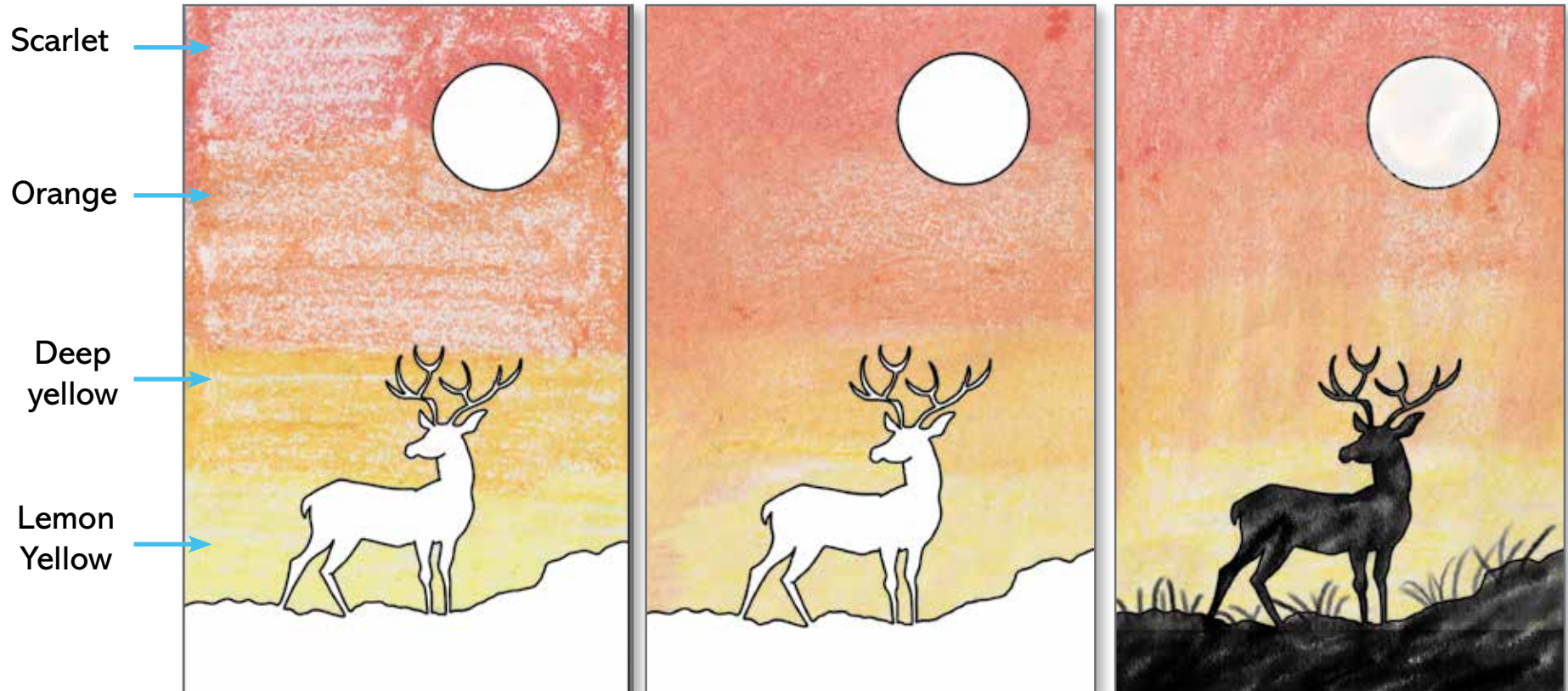

Step 1

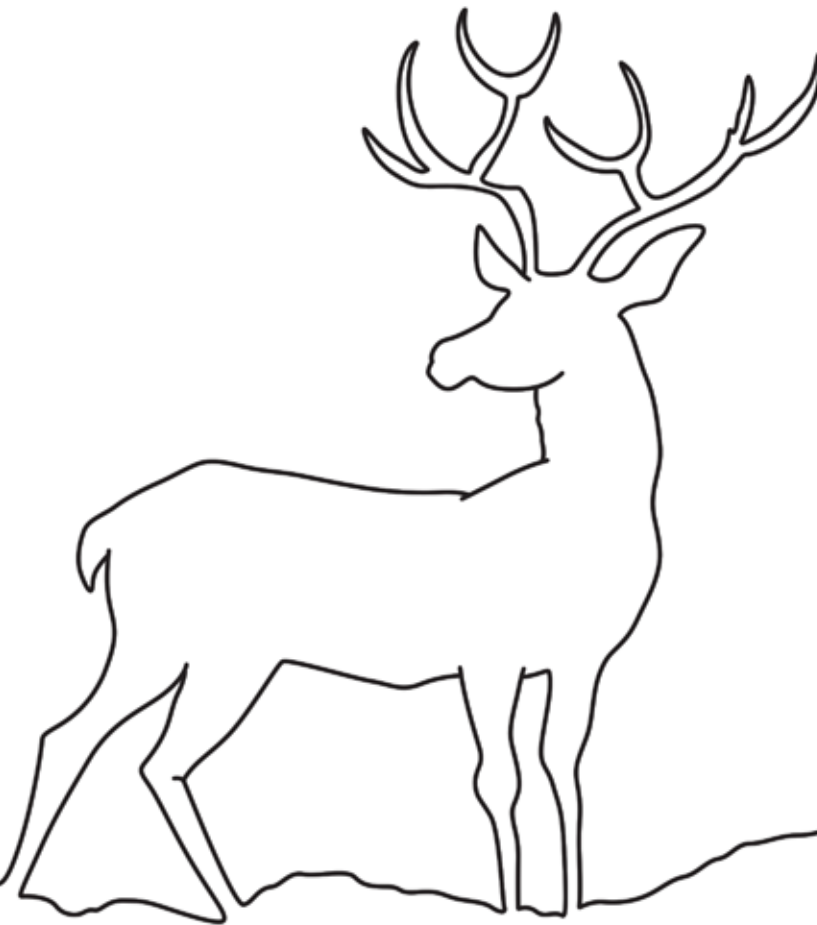
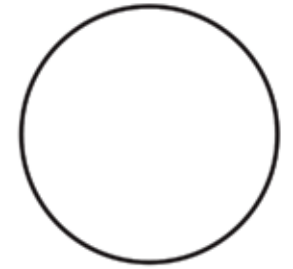
Colour from yellow to orange starting from lighter shades to darker.

Colour the rest of the image in black leaving the moon white.

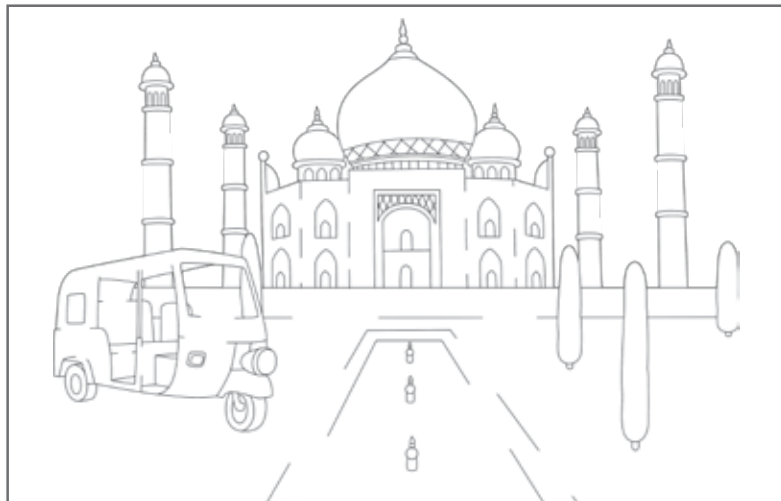


Taj Mahal

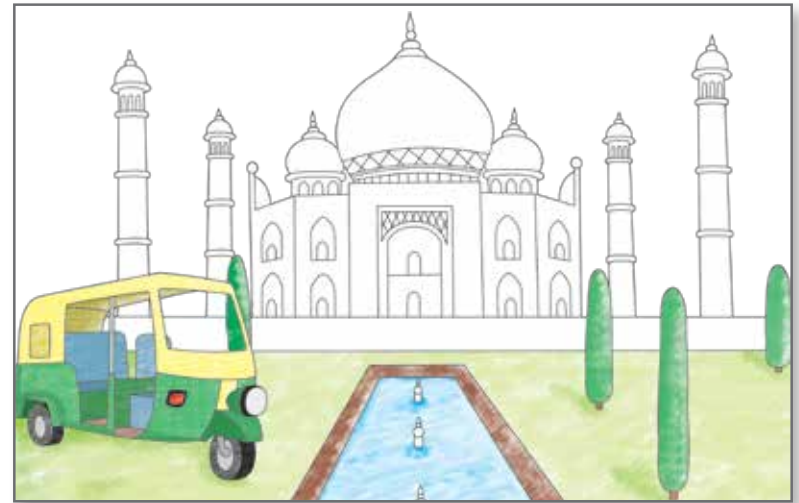
