SLEEPING LINES

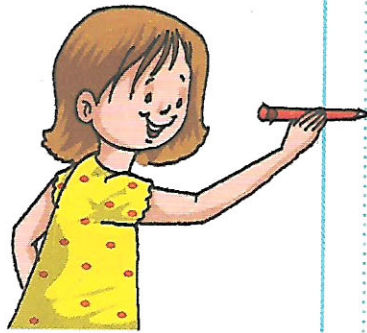


Trace over the dots to complete these lines.
