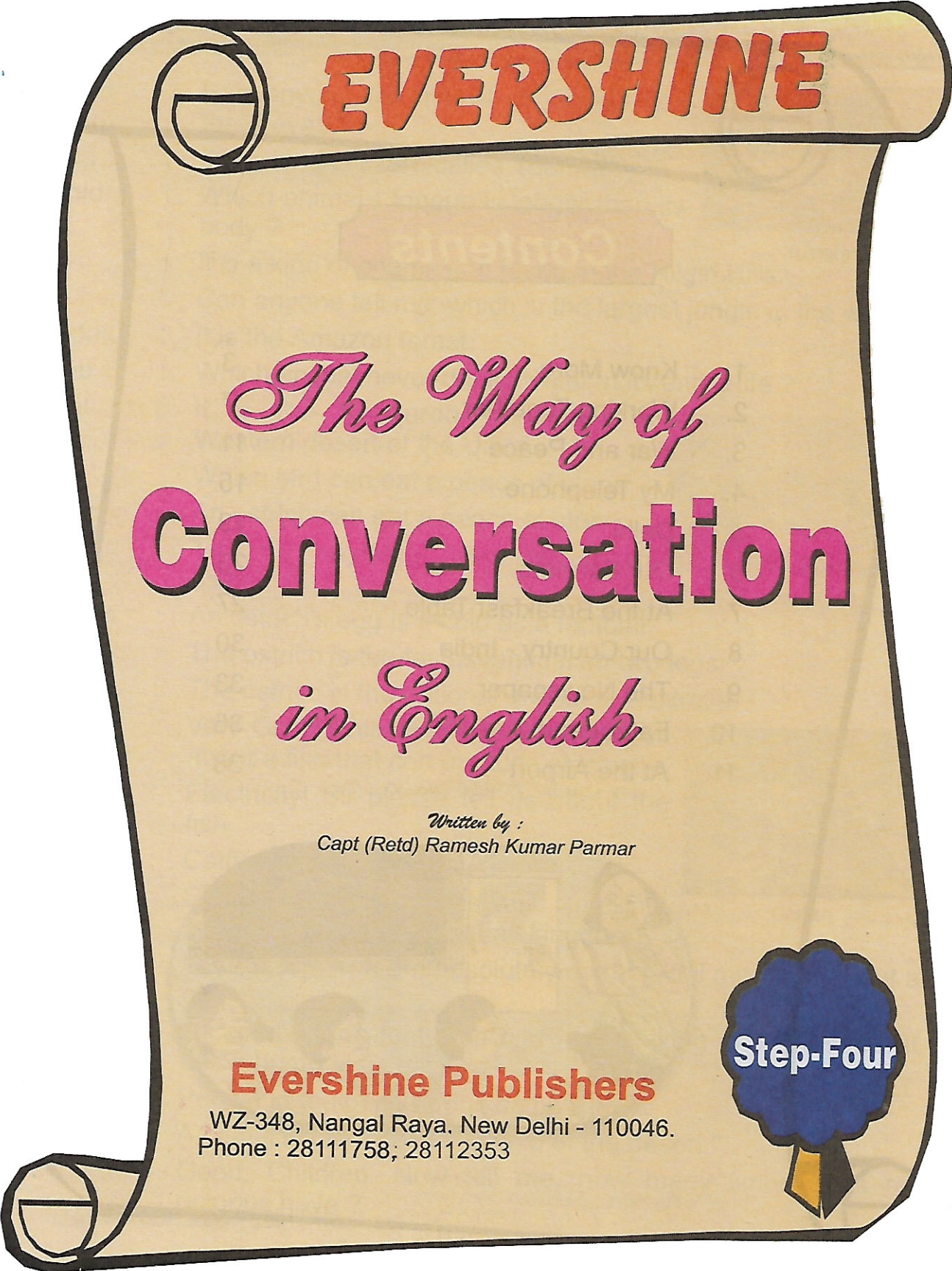

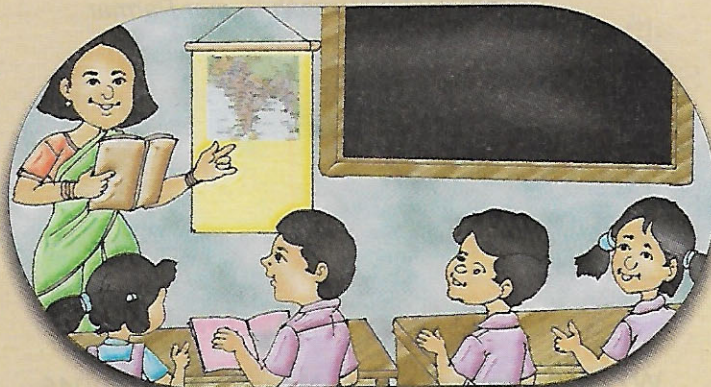
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Step-Four

Fascinating facts (आश्चर्यजनक सत्य)

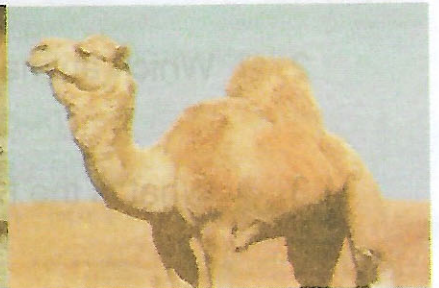
- A female rat can have 12 babies every eight weeks.
